

Youth Camp **Sunday, July 18 - Friday, July 23, 2010** **Information Sheet**

Activities: Music, Worship, Bible Study, Mission Study, Concert, Karaoke, Swimming, Recreation, etc.

Who can attend: Those who have just completed one of the grades 6 - 12.

Cost: \$70.00 for one camper; \$120.00 for two campers from the same household; or \$170.00 for 3 or more campers from the same household. \$14 a day for students if they attend a single day event. The price covers the cost of registration, meals, lodging, special events, snacks and a T-shirt. **If the cost is prohibitive, talk with your pastor, or Director of Missions Phillip Rector (646-3454).**

Registration Deadline: Wednesday, July 14, is the deadline for registration. You may register your camper at www.gasconadevalleybaptist.org and bring your form and camp fee on July 18.

Time: Campers check-in will be from **4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 18**. Dinner will be served to campers and guests at **1:00 p.m., Friday, July 23** and camp will close at that time.

What to bring . . .

Clothing: Clothing that is modest and in keeping with Christian Standards. No short shorts or halter tops, or tops with spaghetti straps. If you can't wear it to school please don't wear it to camp. Swimsuits shall be one piece and not french cut. Those with two piece or french cut swimsuits will be expected to wear a T-shirt at the pool. A beach robe or appropriate clothing shall be worn over the swimsuit as we travel to and from the pool. Bring a jacket or sweater in case of cool nights. Bring your musical instruments. Also bring Christian and karaoke CD's.

Personal Items: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, wash cloths, towels, shampoo, etc.

Do not bring money. Snacks will be provided. BRING BIBLES

Bedding: Either sleeping bag or sheets, blankets, and pillow.

Optional: camera, fans, insecticides, flashlight, clothes hangers, clothes hanger cords

Do not bring: any type of electronic devices (ipods, GameBoys, cell phones), fireworks, knives, water guns, B-B guns, alcohol, tobacco or drugs.

Note: If you drive yourself to camp, you must turn in your car keys to camp directors. You will need written permission from a parent or guardian to come and go from camp.
